Assistants for Children's Activities

Role Description

Helping with various children's activities during family events such as our Wild at White's Family Fun activities, held during Half-term, Easter and Summer holidays. Typical tasks include encouraging people to take part, explaining/demonstrating how to perform the activity, monitoring activities which carry greater risk, demonstrating or running an activity table.

Details will be given in advance by the relevant member of staff. The more people who are interested in getting involved, the more likely we are to develop activities which require your assistance.

Time Commitment

Varies depending on the nature of the activities, but generally speaking we ask for a half-day or day of your time during any of the school holidays.
