Be inspired by Gilbert White, Frank Oates and Lawrence Oates to take a journey into the Natural World. The beautiful historic house that was once the home to Gilbert White is now home to an eclectic museum, gardens and visitor centre.

Explore the museum that commemorates Gilbert White, White, a pioneering 18th Century naturalist, Frank Oates a renowned Victorian explorer and Lawrence Oates, a member of the tragic Terra Nova expedition to the South Pole. We are lucky to be situated in one of the most beautiful areas of the South Downs, and Downs and have 25 acres of garden for our visitors to enjoy. The garden is beautiful all year round, and houses a fascinating mixture of restored heritage garden and natural conservation. Visit our excellent café, which is perfect for groups. Our newest addition to the site is our tap room named the Jubilee Tap. We serve Gilbert White's beer which is brewed on site in from our restored 18th century brew house. The Jubilee Tap also serves a variety of wines, cocktails and guest ales.

Packages

Peak Package (Valid from March–October) The standard admission price for a pre-booked, pre-paid group is £12 per head. This includes an introductory talk and admission to the museum and gardens. Tours and catering options can be added.

Winter Package (Valid from November–February) Admission is £10 per head. This includes an introductory talk and admission to the museum and gardens. Tours and catering options can be added.

Introductory Talk

An introductory talk is offered to all groups at no extra cost and will give a further insight into the history of the house and the three explorers of the natural world that we celebrate.

Tours

Garden Tour With over twenty acres of ancient parkland and some five acres of restored gardens with a focus on 18th century planting, a garden tour is a fascinating way to learn about Gilbert White the Gardener and the plants and features described in his writings.

House Tour Get a special insight into the house and galleries, with a guided tour. Only available to groups under 10 people due to size of the rooms.

All Tours are by prior arrangement only. House tours start from £20, which is for a maximum of 10 people. The tours are limited to 10 people due to the size of the rooms within the museum.

Parking

Our car park is a 2 minute walk from the House. It is situated just off the main road behind the Selborne Arms. The car park can take cars and coaches. At busy times visitors can be dropped off outside the House and coaches can park in lay-bys approximately a mile distant either North or South of the village. Selborne Village

The pretty historic village of Selborne is located within the South Downs National Park. There are superb walks, including up Gilbert White's ZigZag path on to the Selborne Hanger. There is a pottery, a selection of village shops, and a café on the high street, and The Selborne Arms Pub. The village church, where Gilbert White is buried, has two stained glass windows commemorating him, is directly opposite the Museum, and well worth a visit.

Payment

We require payment in full for group admission, tours and catering a minimum of fourteen days prior to your visit. We will send an invoice to you that must be paid 14 days prior to your visit. Alternatively, you can send a cheque for the amount owed. We do not accept over the phone payments.
