The beautiful historic house that was once the home to Gilbert White is now home to an eclectic museum, gardens and visitor centre. Explore the museum that commemorates Gilbert White, White, a pioneering 18th Century naturalist, Frank Oates a renowned Victorian explorer and Lawrence Oates, a member of the tragic Terra Nova expedition to the South Pole.

We are lucky to be situated in one of the most beautiful areas of the South Downs, and have 25 acres of garden for our visitors to enjoy. The garden is beautiful all year round, and houses a fascinating mixture of restored heritage garden and natural conservation. Visit our excellent café, which is perfect for groups. Our newest addition to the site is our tap room named the Jubilee Tap. We serve Gilbert White's beer which is brewed on site in from our restored 18th century brew house. The Jubilee Tap also serves a variety of wines, cocktails and guest ales.

We have an excellent cafe and will strive to cater for your needs, whether that is coffee on arrival or lunch.


Depending on the size of your group, and availability of the cafe may impact whether or not we can cater.

## **Tours**
