



What adventures would Timothy have if he came to live at your house?

You could write about Timothy or you could imagine you are Timothy and describe everything from his point of view. You can use adjectives from our adjective scavenger hunt sheet to help you with your descriptions.

The Story Begins: Describe where the story is taking place and introduce Timothy, your main character. Remember to use all your senses in your description – what can Timothy hear, smell, see, feel or taste?

The Problem: A good way to develop your story is to give Timothy a problem. It doesn't have to be very dramatic: getting lost, feeling hungry, getting stuck somewhere are all good possibilities. Remember to include how he is feeling.

The Resolution: How does Timothy get out of this tricky situation? How does he feel at the end?
